VENUES: Fringe takes place in a number of venues across Whangārei; some you may be familiar with, others will be new and unique to Fringe.

To find your way around, all venues are listed with addresses on the next page.

TICKETS ARE ON SALE NOW! Visit eventfinda.co.nz – venues are small and many shows will sell out, so book now. Ticketing fees apply to all ticketed events.

BOX OFFICE: Buy tickets in person at the official Fringe box office, at ONEONESIX (116 Bank St). Open 10am–1pm, Monday to Friday from September 9 to October 11.

ALL ABOUT PRICING: You may see two or more prices at the bottom of each event listing, eg. \$25/\$10. The first price is the full/adult price; the second is the concession or child price. 'Concession' applies to holders of Gold Cards, Community Services Cards and student IDs; 'child' applies to 13 years and under. If three different prices are displayed, it will be adult/concession/child.

KOHA EVENTS: Kudos to the artists who want to make their work as accessible as possible! You may still need to register for these events, as space is limited.

TRIGGER WARNINGS: Fringe events can get fruity and challenging – it's part of the fun. But if you want to be prepared, look out for the trigger warnings on individual Eventfinda listings. Also, look for age ratings in event listings.
